1. Welcome to hybrid learning.
  - a. Please bring a lock, all band students must have their own locker. We will checkout lockers during ensemble classes this week. You can store your instrument in the band room until your ensemble class period. Please take your instrument home daily as custodial staff will be spraying a sanitizing mist into lockers each evening.
  - b. Bring a water bottle to school, the drinking fountains are shut down but the drinking fountains with water bottle spouts are still operating.
2. Band Lockers:
  - a. All band students will checkout a locker this year and all band belongings must live in the locker when not in use. There will be no instruments and/or cases and personal belongings left on the floor.
  - b. Students may not share a locker, and must use the smallest possible locker to accommodate your instrument(s).
  - c. **You must bring a master lock (or similar size/style) for your band locker. We will checkout lockers during class next week.**
  - d. District personnel will be spraying a sanitizing mist throughout the school daily. Do not leave belongings in your band locker that could be damaged by a sanitizing product.
  - e. Regular lockers are not being checked out. You may not use your band locker for items unrelated to band.
