Uniform Care

Jackets: Store with the shoulders folded in. Machine wash in warm or cold water. Do NOT use liquid fabric softener. Dry on a low setting or air dry. Stains can be spot treated but do NOT bleach. Do NOT dry clean.

Pants: Machine wash in warm or cold water. Do NOT use liquid fabric softener. Do NOT bleach. Dry on a low setting or air dry. Do NOT dry clean.

Gauntlets: Hand wash or machine wash in warm or cold water. Make sure to velcro gauntlets together if machine washing. Air dry only. Dry flat. Do NOT machine dry. Do NOT bleach. Stains can be spot treated.

If you put the gauntlets in the dryer, they turn blue and have to be immediately rewashed or they have a blue tinge. Air dry only.
