## **Band, Choir and Orchestra Students ONLY!**

Any student that needs to return an instrument, band uniform, or pick up an instrument can do so on either Thursday, May 21st or Friday, May 22nd between 9am - noon. Seniors who have borrowed/rented an instrument and other students who have an instrument that needs to be repaired or are moving, should plan on returning them to the school during these days. Students who are returning to Mead HS next year may keep their instrument over the summer. If you choose to do this, please make sure it is serviced appropriately for use next year.

Students should plan on parking in the north parking lot behind the B wing (band hallway). All transactions, handing in or picking up, will be done outside so that no student will enter the building.
