- 1. MHS Football is in the playoffs! We will be performing at the game THIS Saturday after the Veterans Day Parade. A couple of notes about this football game:
 - a. We <u>WILL</u> be in the stands/bleachers for this game!
 - b. Choir will take care of the National Anthem in case we are late getting back from the parade.
 - c. We will play in the stands all four quarters, but we will not perform a halftime show. Expect to play a lot while we are in the stands.
 - *d. Please contact Mr. Lemons ASAP if you have a conflict with this performance.* Football players are not expected to march in the Veterans Day Parade, and will not need instruments since we are not performing a halftime show.
- 2. Longmont Veterans Day Parade, THIS Saturday. 9:15 AM arrival at Mead HS. Buses depart at 9:45. Full uniforms (no feathers). Please have Washington Post March memorized. *Football players are exempt from this performance due to Playoffs.*
- 3. Because we are trying to return from the Vets Day Parade before Kickoff, we will <u>NOT</u> be attending the lunch at the VFW. Please bring a sack lunch to eat when we return from the parade before marching down to the football game.
- 4. The Mead HS Veterans Day Assembly is scheduled for Monday, November 12. Concert/Symphonic Combined will perform "America The Beautiful" and "Prestissimo" during the assembly. Please dress up for this event (concert black/white not required).
- Juniors and Seniors should consider auditioning for All-State. The live auditions are held at Longmont High School on November 28. Students need to let Mr. Lemons know ASAP if they would like to audition so a time slot can be reserved. Slots run from 8 AM – 10:30 AM.
- 6. The recommended practice time at home is:
 - a. Beginner (1 year experience) 20-30 minutes a day/5 times a week.
 - b. Intermediate (2-3 years experience) 30-45 minutes a day/5 times a week.
 - c. Advanced (4-5 years experience) 45-60 minutes a day/5-6 times a week.
- 7. The Music Department is currently working on the program order for the Holiday Gala. Everyone is needed both nights for the combined piece, but a detailed and precise concert order is TBA. (December 4 and 5).
- 8. To prepare the combined piece with Choir and Orchestra, we will hold a Full Music Department Dress Rehearsal on Thursday, November 29 from 2:30 4:00 PM.
- 9. The Marching Band will participate in two holiday parades: December 1 in Mead, and December 8 in Longmont.
